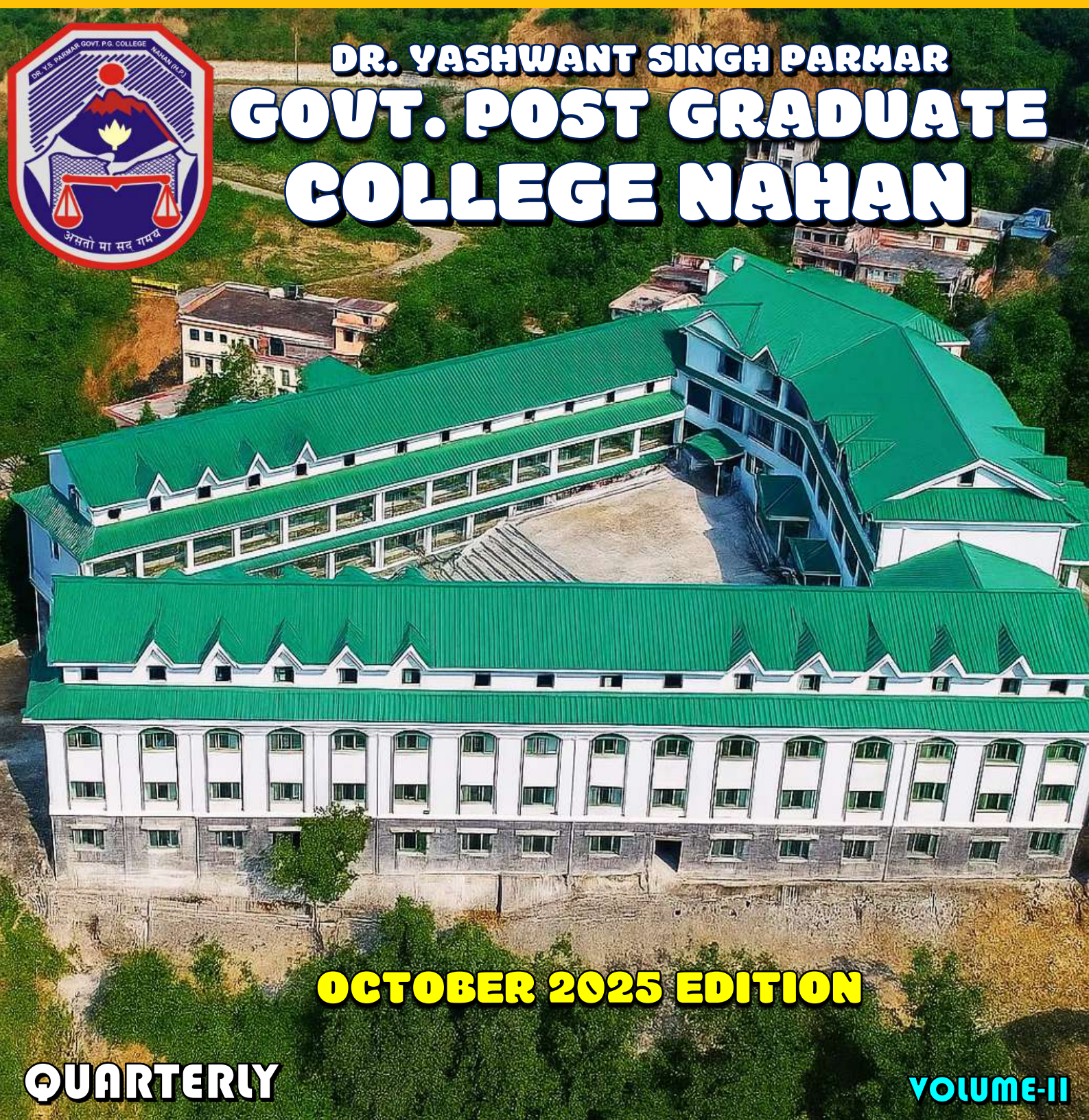

In 1954, the Guru Ram Rai Trust established a Degree College at Nahan, which initially functioned from the Royal Amar Boarding. In June 1963, the college was taken over by the Department of Education as a constituent college of Punjab University at the initiative of Dr. U. S. Parmar, the first Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh. In 1971, the college was affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla.



The college's vision, "*Asato Ma Sad Gamaya*," derived from Vedic philosophy and enshrined in the *Brihadaranyaka Upanishad*, guides students from the unreal to the real, from darkness to light, and from death to immortality. In 2021, the college achieved a significant milestone by receiving prestigious accreditation from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). **Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar Government P.G. College, Nahan**, located at Banog about 3 km from the main town, is a UGC-recognized institution permanently affiliated with HPU Shimla. The campus consists of four main blocks—Administrative, Arts & Commerce, Science, and RUSA Blocks. The college has around 90 staff members and over 2,500 students enrolled in the Arts, Science, and Commerce streams, along with vocational and professional programs such as BCA, PGDCA, and B.Voc. It also offers postgraduate courses in English, Political Science, and Economics.

The institution is dedicated to the all-round development of its students through various clubs, societies, and extension wings, including NSS, NCC, Rover & Ranger, Red Ribbon Club, Eco Club, Chemicos, Road Safety Club, Unnat Bharat Abhigan, IIRS-ISRO Outreach Programme, Literary Society, and Theatre Club. With a glorious past and the distinguished achievements of its alumni across the world, the college remains committed to providing an education that not only imparts knowledge but also builds character—preparing students to lead purposeful lives and make meaningful contributions to society.

Dr. Jagdish Chand, Assistant Professor of Geography at Govt. PG College, Nahan, hails from Village Kajwa, District Sirmour. He holds M.A., M.Phil., and Ph.D. degrees with double gold medals, along with certifications in Remote Sensing & GIS from the Indian Institute of Remote Sensing (ISRO) and the AICTE. He also holds a Certification in Disaster Management from NIDM (Ministry of Home Affairs), a PG Diploma in Geospatial Technology Applications in Rural Development from NIRD Hyderabad, a PG Diploma in Disaster Management, and a PG Diploma in Urban Planning and Development. He has qualified UGC-NET/JRF and SLET.

He has coordinated more than 100 IIRS-ISRO Outreach Programmes at Govt. PG College Nahan and Govt. College Sangrah. As the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Coordinator, he has led impactful initiatives in ten villages under the Ministry of Education and AICTE. He has published more than 50 research papers in *UGC CARE-listed*, *SCOPUS*, *Web of Science*, national, and international journals. He has authored six books—two published in Germany, two in the United States, and two in India—along with eight book chapters. He has presented over 100 research papers in national & international conferences / seminars and participated in more than 80 professional trainings/workshops organized by *India Space Lab*, *NRSC*, *IIRS*, *ISRO*, *IIPA*, *NIDM*, *IIT Delhi*, *DST*, *CSSTEAP*, the *United Nations*, *ESRI*, *JAXA*, and *NASA*. He is a Key Resource Person for Disaster Management at SCERT Solan. He holds over 20 patents in India and the U.K., developed with scientists, engineers, and researchers across disaster management, remote sensing–GIS, agriculture, curriculum design, higher education, and stress-reduction technologies.

He was a member of the NEP-2020 implementation committee for Geography, Department of Higher Education, Govt. of H.P., 2021. He served as a member of the Evaluation Committee for the School Safety Disaster Management Plan of Himachal Pradesh, 2024 and as a member of the Self Assessment Report Committee for Solan Cluster, 2024. He is also a member of the Indian Society of Remote Sensing, the National Association of Geographers, India, and the International Society for Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing.

Dr. Jagdish Chand has received several prestigious honors, including the *"Vidhya Visharat"* & *"Sirmour Ratan"*. He earned the *"Best Coordinator Award"* 2020 and *"Appreciation Certificates"* (2018, 2019 & 2024) from Indian Institute of Remote Sensing (ISRO) Dehradun. He received the *"Best Teacher Award"* twice (2023-24 & 2024-25) from the National Edu Trust of India (Ministry of MSME, Government of India).

In 2025, for the first time in the college's history, he was honoured by the H.P. State Government with the *"State Teachers Award 2025"* on 5th September 2025.

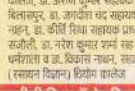

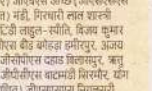

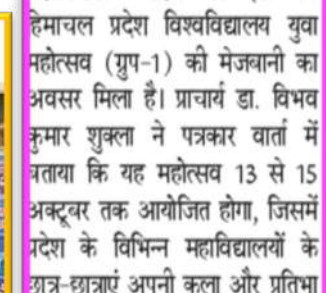
