

Students' Feedback Analysis Regarding Curriculum (Academic Session: 2021-22)




1. Relevance of the contents of the curriculum to the courses and program you studied. 357 responses




2. Relevance of the syllabus with Practical / Lab / Project Work / Field work. 357 responses




3. The contents of the curriculum (syllabus) are up to date. 357 responses



4. The objectives and outcomes of the courses and programmes are well defined and clear $^{357\,\text{responses}}$




5. The size of curriculum is appropriate in terms of the load on the student. 357 responses




6. Relevance of the syllabus for higher studies.






8. The curriculum fosters entrepreneurship.








11. The books prescribed/listed as reference materials in the syllabus are relevant and appropriate.






13. Do you feel co-curricular and extra-curricular activities organized in the college promote overall development of the students?




