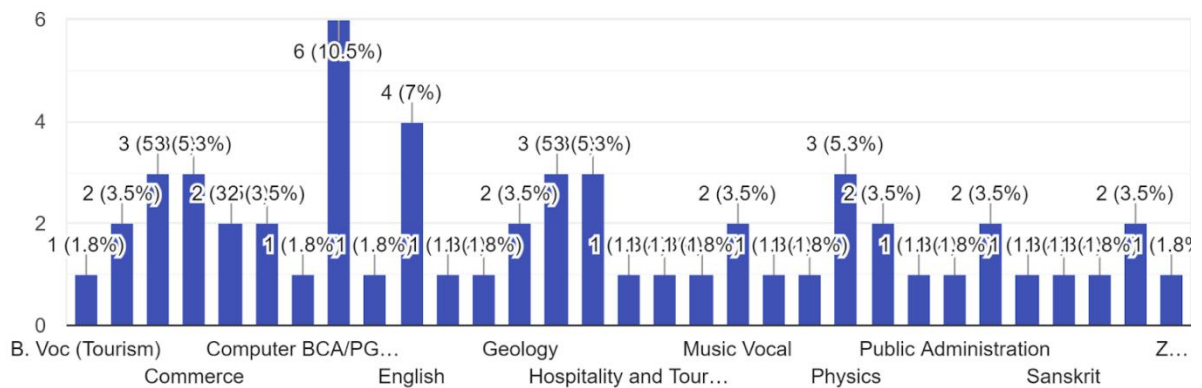


Teacher's Feedback Analysis Regarding Curriculum (Academic Session 2021-22)

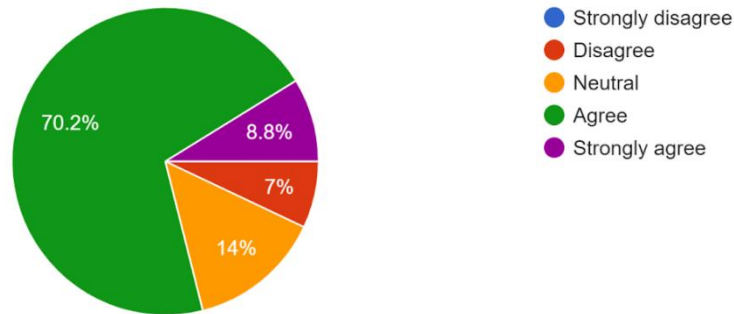

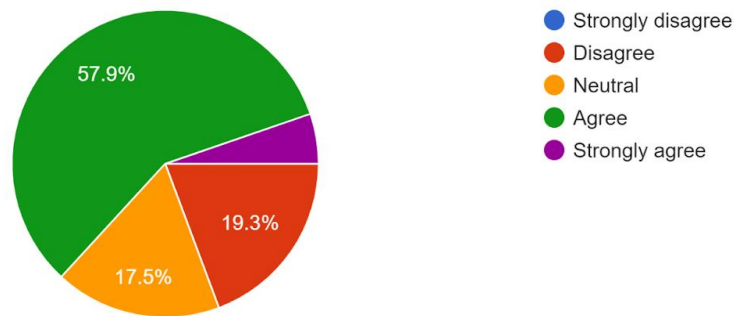
1. The syllabus is suitable to the courses/ program and need based.

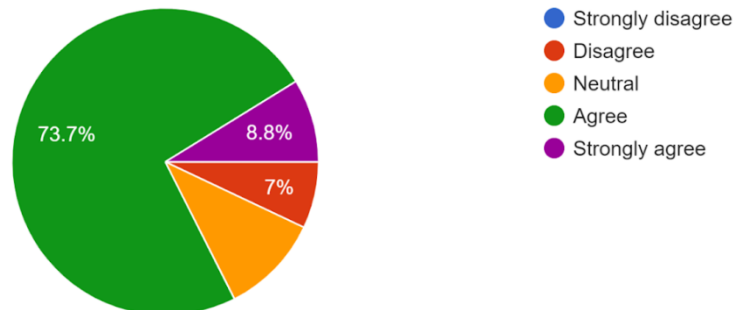
2. The contents of the curriculum are up to date.

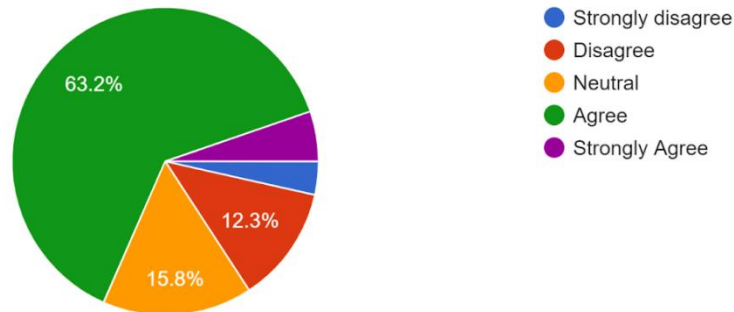
3. The objectives and outcomes of the courses and programmes are well defined and clear to teachers and students.

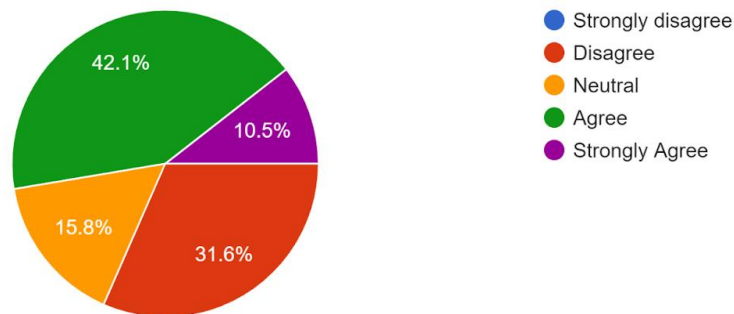
4. The size of curriculum is appropriate in terms of the load on the student.

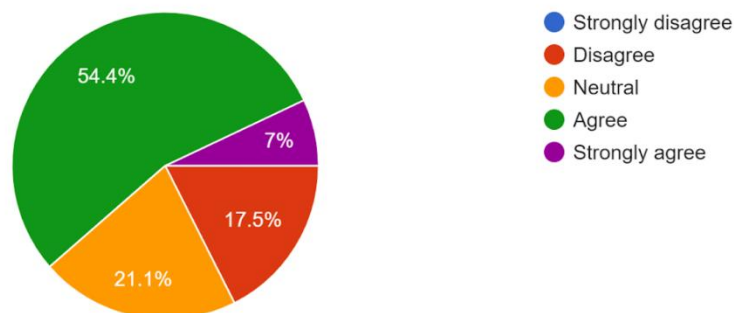
5. The curriculum has focus on skill development.

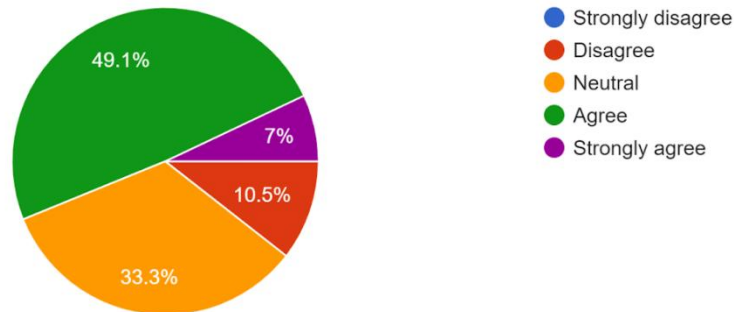
6. The curriculum is contributing to the holistic growth of students.

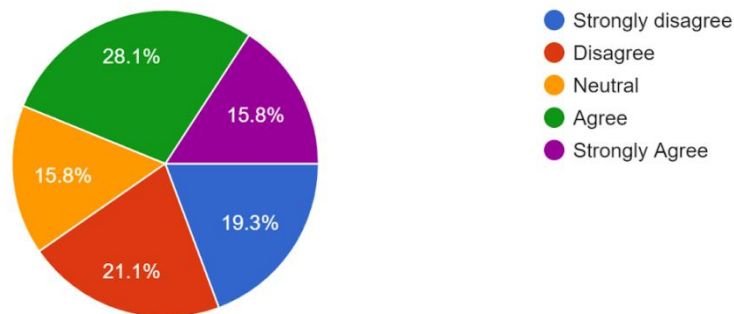
7. Is the curriculum helpful for the preparation of competitive examinations?

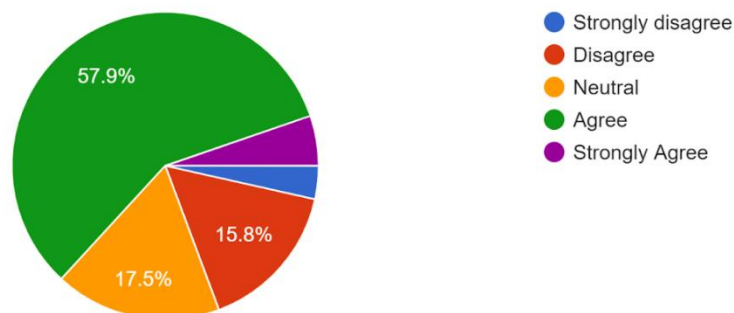
8. The class has an ideal Teacher-taught ratio.

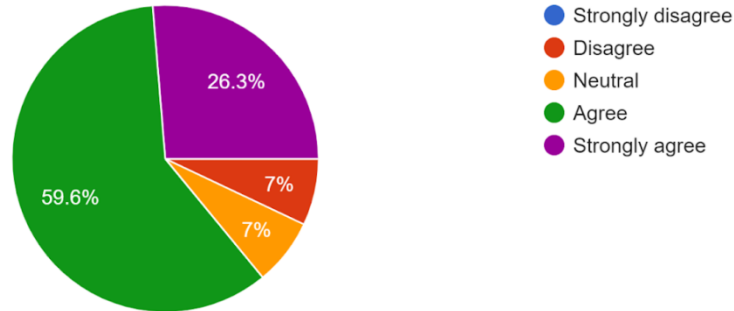
9. The evaluation scheme designed for each of the course and program is appropriate.

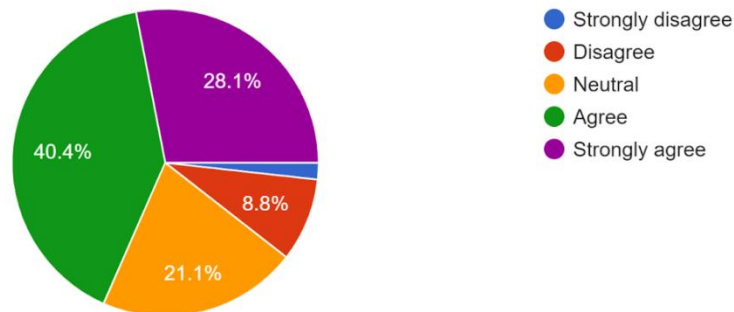
10. Teachers have the freedom to adopt new techniques/strategies of teaching and evaluation such as seminar presentations, group discussions and learners' participations.

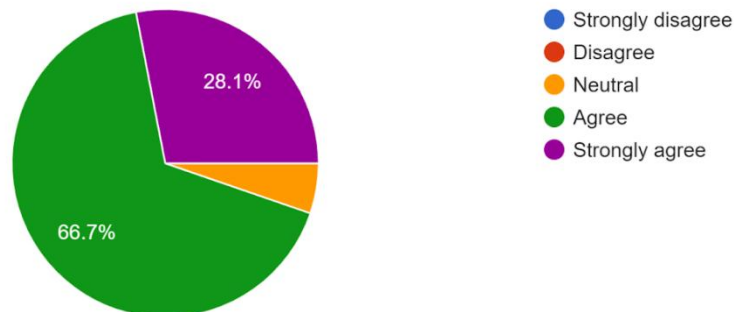
11. Do you feel teaching hours suffer due to extra assignments given to teachers?

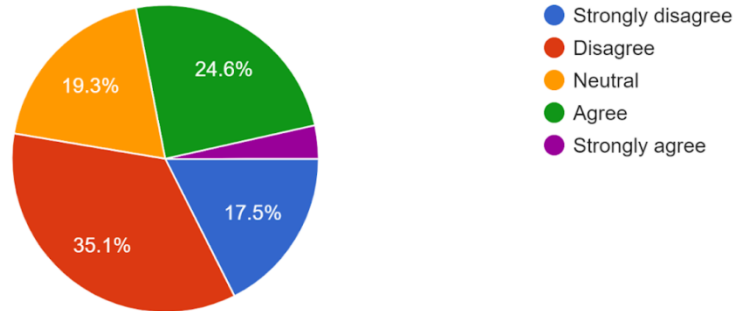
12. Internal examinations are conducted with proper coverage of the syllabus.

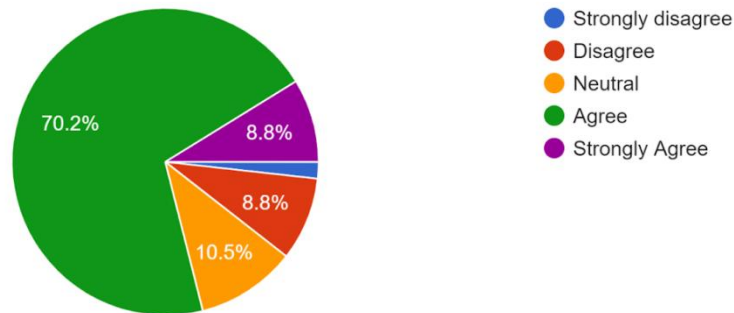
13. Teachers have the freedom to propose, modify, suggest and incorporate new topics in the course/ curriculum.

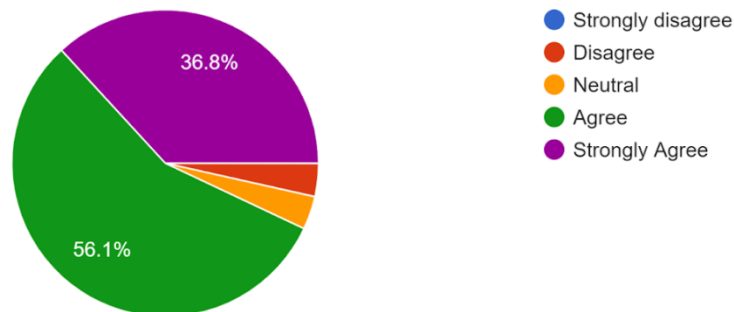
14. The curriculum promotes participatory learning through seminar presentation, group discussions etc.

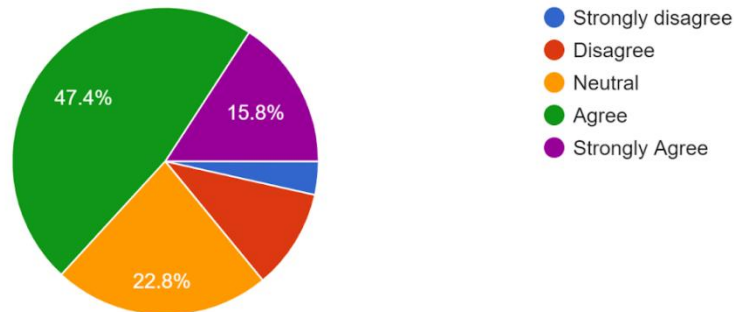
15. Sports, cocurricular and extracurricular activities promote overall development of the students.

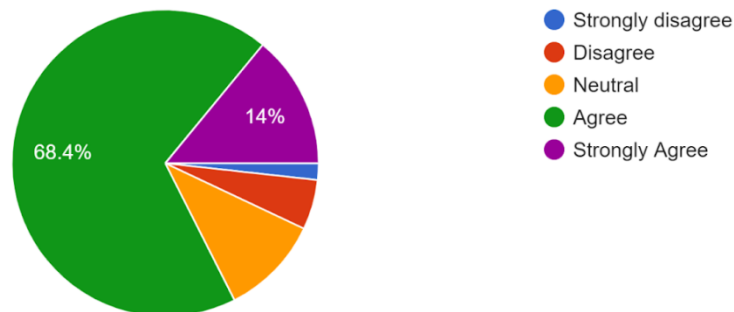
16. The course/syllabus has good balance between theory and application or practical.

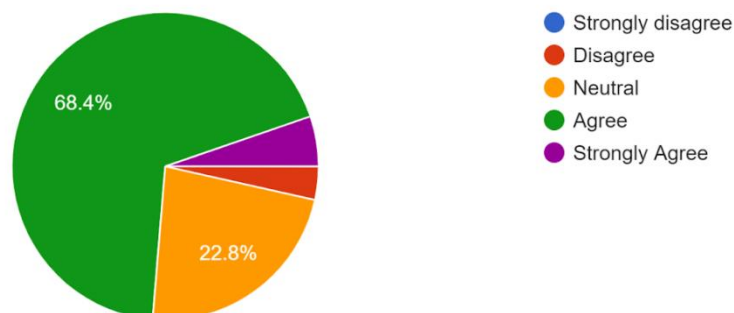
17. The course/syllabus of your subject increased your knowledge and perspective in the subject area.

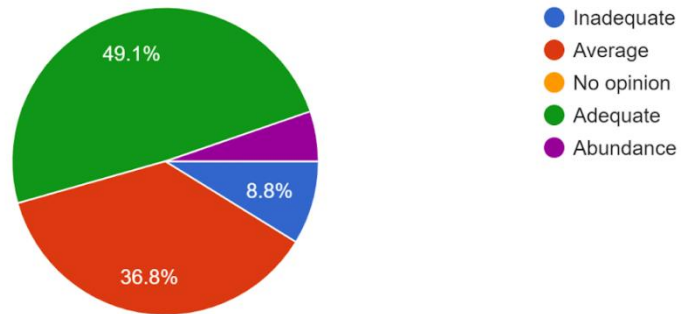

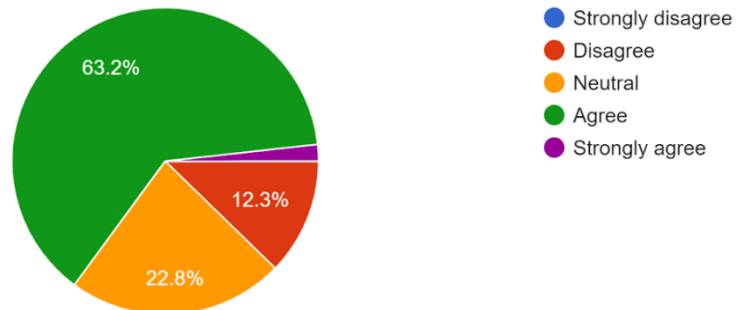
19. Availability of teaching resources and reference books in the college.

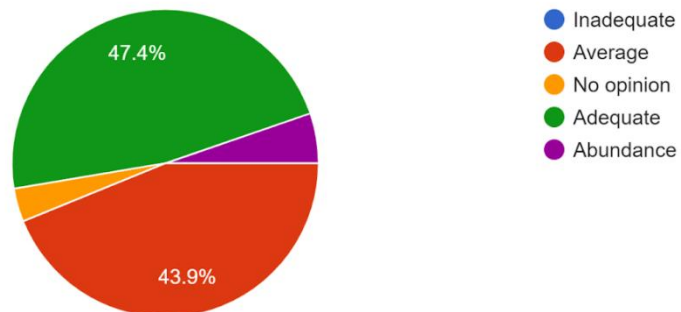
