a. ACADEMIC CALENDAR OF UNIVERSITY FOR UG &PG

The institution prepares its own calendar in the college in tandem with the academic calendar of the HP University to conduct Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) The college follows the curriculum and examination system as prescribed by HP University, Shimla. Mid-Term (House examinations) are held each year and are designed in the format of HPU examination so that the students may cultivate the culture of writing answers as per the standard. The students write answers for practice and the teachers guide them about the necessary improvements. Class discussion is facilitated which helps in clarifying the concepts. Students are also encouraged to make presentations in the class on the topics of their choice. As per the HP University norms internal assessment in all UG and PG classes is prepared. The teachers award internal assessment based on marks secured in the house exams, assignment work along with class participation/interaction of the student and regularity in the class.

The institution has adopted a "learner-centric approach" and Annual Quality Assurance Report of DR.YASHWANT SINGH PARMAR GOVERNMENT POST GRADUATE COLLEGE,NAHAN evaluates students' knowledge acquisition, skill development and employment readiness. The attainment levels of the course outcomes are measured by the concerned course handling faculty member through various assessment methods. Being an affiliated college of Himachal Pradesh University, student's academic performance is evaluated through 70% of total marks in term end University Examinations and 30% marks at college level comprehensive continuous internal evaluation. The assessment of the attainment of course outcomes is supplemented by the comprehensive continuous internal evaluation system which includes marks of mid-term exams, assignments given to students, ICT enabled seminars and presentations, individual/ group projects followed by viva voce on the project completed. Apart from this the course outcomes are also evaluated in the term end theory and practical examinations. However, the Programme outcome attainment is measured in respect of all the students of a programme based on their final CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) score at the time of passing the programme. The programme outcome attainment is determined by the percentage of student scoring CGPA.

Introduction:

The socio-economic survey of Sain Ki Sher village, Himachal Pradesh, was part of the ongoing efforts under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. It involved the participation of NSS volunteers who worked closely with local families to understand their living conditions, economic activities, social structure, and educational status. **This was a follow-up survey to one conducted in February 2023, which had provided valuable insights into the village's infrastructural and social issues.** A socio-economic and educational survey was conducted in the village of Sain Ki Sher, Himachal Pradesh. The survey aimed to gather detailed information about the population, economic activities, animal husbandry, and social structure of the households. The following report highlights key findings from the survey, which can help in understanding the village's demographic and economic characteristics.

Key Findings from the 2023 Survey:

एनएसएस के कार्यक्रम अधिकारी प्रोफेंसर पंकज चांडक ने बताया कि इस दीरान गांव के उपप्रधान सतेंद्र सिंह व सोमदत्त भी मौजूद रहे। उन्होंने बताया कि सरकार को योजनाओं का घरातल पर किस तरह से उतर रही है का सर्वे रख्यंसेवकों द्वारा किया गया, जिसमें निर्मल घोषित ग्राम पंचायत सैन को सेर में पाया गया है कि अभी भी चार से पांच परिवार के पास निजी शौंचालय नहां है। लहां यह पारवार सार्वजनिक शीचालनों का प्रयोग कर रहे हैं। वहाँ चुकि पंचायत निर्मल घोषित हो चुकी हैं तो यहाँ शीचालय निर्माण इत्यादि के लिए भी सरकारी फेंड नहीं मिल सकता है।

वहीं यह भी सबें के दौरान पाया गया है कि पंचायत के लोग पेयजल को अभी भी खड़ू से आपूर्ति कर रहे हैं। वहीं सरकार को आरे से पेयजल योजना का लाभ लोगों को यहां नहीं मिल पा रहा है। एनएसएस कार्यक्रम अधिकारी प्रोफेसर पर्कज चांडक ने बताया कि एनएसएस के सात दिवसीय आवासीय शिविर में महाविद्यालय के 80 छात्र-छात्राएँ बिरोप सेवा अभियान में हिस्सा ले रहे है।

जिसके तहत नाहन क्षेत्र के आठ किलोमीटर के दायरे के पांच गांवों को एडाप्ट कर यहां पर सेवा अभियान को चलाया गया है। वहीं सायंकालीन गतिविधियों में सांस्कृतिक कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया जा रहा है। In the February 2023 survey, Sain Ki Sher was documented as an Open Defecation Free (ODF) Panchayat. However, the survey revealed a significant gap—5 households were found to lack toilet facilities. This issue came to light due to the separation of joint families, which had not been reflected in official records. When these findings were conveyed to the Gram Panchayat and district media authorities through channels, the matter was investigated, and the affected households were subsequently provided with toilet facilities.

2024 Survey Overview:

In February 2024, another detailed survey was carried out with the help of NSS volunteers. The focus of this survey was to reassess the improvements made since the last year, particularly regarding sanitation facilities, and to gather updated socio-economic data.




D. Social and Religious Composition:

The religious and social composition of the village showcases a predominantly Hindu community with a mix of castes. The survey data provides valuable insights that can guide development initiatives focused on improving economic opportunities and promoting educational growth in the village.

The socio-economic survey of Sain Ki Sher has highlighted the village's progress in sanitation, economic activities, and education. The efforts of NSS volunteers, along with the guidance of Dr. Pankaj Chandak, Prof. Lakshita, and Prof. Devendra, have helped bring attention to critical issues, such as sanitation gaps. The successful provision of toilet facilities to households identified in the previous survey exemplifies the impact that such initiatives can have on rural development.


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

4) Internal assessment mechanism (quizzes, Class test, presentation, assignment/result of students

- (iv) 10 marks for Assignment/Seminar/Class Test/Tutorial/Quiz etc.

Instructions for Class Teachers for Conducting Class Test and House Test and Evaluation of Assignments/Seminar/Class Test/Tutorial/Quiz etc.

Note: Time allowed for conducting Class Test and House Test shall be 1 Hour & 1.30 Hours respectively.

(A). Mode of Conducting Class Test and House Test:

Class Test will be conducted after the completion of 40 % of syllabus and House Test after 75 % of syllabus. House Test shall consist of the course covered after Class Test. Three types of questions shall be set in both Tests:

- 1. Five defining questions of 1 mark each = 5 marks.
- 2. Two questions of short answer-type in about 100 words each of 2.5 marks = 5 marks.
- 3. Two questions of about 300 words (each of 5 marks) = 10 marks.

Total marks 5+5 +10 = 20 marks (reduced in proportion of the total marks.)

Total weightage: 5 marks for Class Test and 10 marks for House Test.

(B) Distribution of marks for evaluation of Tutorial/Home Assignment/ Field Report and Survey. (in case of Skill Enhancement Courses) :

- 1. 4 marks are assigned for the quality of contents and structure of the assignment.
- 3 marks are assigned for the clarity of language of the script (English or Hindi) and its presentation in the classroom.
- 3 marks are assigned for defending the assignment in the classroom or in group discussion.

Total marks (4 +3+3) = 10 marks.

Tutorial/Home Assignments may not be insisted upon skill enhancement courses. However, field report & survey (depending on applicability of the respective course) is an essential part of that course.

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COURSE EVALUATION

All Courses (Core and Elective) offered by Department of Economics will have an evaluation system that comprises of the following two components:

- 1. Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA) accounting for 30% of the final grade that a student gets in a course, and
- 2. End of Year Examination (EYE) accounting for the remaining 70% of the final grade that the student gets in a course.

Overall Pass marks are 40%. However, a student will have to secure a minimum of 35% in <u>both</u> the components i.e. CCA and EYE separately with to become eligible to be declared successful in a course.



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
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
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
