
## 1) MODE OF TEACHING

### i. BLENDED TEACHING

The teachers in our college use the blended teaching method, also known as blended learning, which combines traditional lecture method with technology-based teaching. Thus, classroom instructions are combined with digital learning tools. In a true blended learning environment, both the student and the teacher should be physically located in the same space. Most of the teachers use ICT enabled tools for effective teaching-learning process.

In view of this the college faculty is encouraged to attend various faculty development programmes on ICT organised by UGC HRDC (Human Resource Development Centres), HPSCERT (Himachal Pradesh State Council for Educational Research and Training), HIPA (Himachal Institute of Public Administration and various universities and colleges. The teachers also attend online courses in ICT. The faculty has sharpened its communication and curriculum delivery skills with the use of ICT which is reflected in the e-resources prepared by the faculty themselves.



## ii. FLIPPED CLASSROOM

Flipped classroom teaching is an instructional approach where traditional learning dynamics are reversed. In this method, students first explore new content on their own, usually through online resources, videos, or reading materials, outside the classroom. The goal is to use class time for active learning and social interaction, while moving content delivery outside of class. Thus, classroom time is dedicated to discussions, problem-solving, and applying the knowledge in interactive, collaborative activities under the guidance of the teacher.

In a flipped classroom, teachers:

- Pre-record lectures or create or share other online resources.
- Post these resources for students to watch before class.
- Spend class time on small group activities and individual attention.
- Assist students as they work through assignments during class.

The flipped classroom approach is being adopted in a phased and selective manner in the college, considering the diverse geographical backgrounds of students and variability in network connectivity, particularly for those from remote and hilly areas. As uniform implementation is presently challenging, faculty members utilize online resources within the classroom using the college's 100% Wi-Fi-enabled infrastructure. These resources are discussed through interactive and brainstorming sessions, encouraging students to observe and relate new concepts to their immediate surroundings. The same digital content is also shared through WhatsApp groups to support revision and self-paced learning. Additionally, students are trained to give demonstrations through PowerPoint presentations, peer learning, and peer teaching methods before the teacher provides a detailed explanation. This practice promotes active and collaborative learning and fulfills the essential criteria of the flipped classroom model by engaging students with content prior to in-depth classroom instruction. Though the practice is yet to be fully adopted, the faculty is gradually transitioning towards this pedagogy, keeping in view students' flexibility, accessibility, and economic constraints to ensure an inclusive and learner-centric teaching-learning process.





### **iii. AS PER NEED OF DIFFERENT GROUPS OF STUDENTS**

The college organizes an orientation program for UG and PG students annually, assessing their learning levels through post-admission MCQ tests. To support slow learners, the college offers bridge courses, remedial classes, self-learning materials, peer teaching, question banks, For advanced learners, the college provides extensive library resources, free coaching for IAS and HPAS exams, advanced add-on courses, scholarships, cash awards, merit certificates, class seminars, presentations, and student projects. Additionally, top-performing students receive laptops from the Government of Himachal Pradesh under the Srinivas Ramanujan Student Digital Yojana.




**Brief report:**

### **I. Teaching Schedule**

#### *a. ACADEMIC CALENDAR OF UNIVERSITY FOR UG &PG*

The institution prepares its own calendar in the college in tandem with the academic calendar of the HP University to conduct Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) The college follows the curriculum and examination system as prescribed by HP University, Shimla. Mid-Term (House examinations) are held each year and are designed in the format of HPU examination so that the students may cultivate the culture of writing answers as per the standard. The students write answers for practice, and teachers guide them about the necessary improvements. Class discussion is facilitated which helps in clarifying the concepts. Students are also encouraged to make presentations in the class on the topics of their choice. As per the HP University norms internal assessment in all UG and PG classes is prepared. The teachers award internal assessment based on marks secured in the house exams, assignment work along with class participation/interaction of the student and regularity in the class.





The institution has adopted a “learner-centric approach” and Annual Quality Assurance Report of DR. YASHWANT SINGH PARMAR GOVERNMENT POST GRADUATE COLLEGE, NAHAN evaluates students’ knowledge acquisition, skill development and employment readiness. The attainment levels of the course outcomes are measured by the concerned course handling faculty member through various assessment methods. Being an affiliated college of Himachal Pradesh University, student’s academic performance is evaluated through 70% of total marks in term end University Examinations and 30% marks at college level comprehensive continuous internal evaluation. The assessment of the attainment of course outcomes is supplemented by the comprehensive continuous internal evaluation system which includes marks of mid-term exams, assignments given to students, ICT enabled seminars and presentations, individual/ group projects followed by viva voce on the project completed.
