

#### i. *Roof top solar plants and purchase solar street lights is in pipeline*

The main energy source is renewable energy source in the form of hydroelectricity from H.P. State Electricity board. Solar energy is the renewable and abundant. Solar Roof Top Power Plant (50KW) has been installed in the college which has reduced the dependency on the grid and provided a buffer against fluctuating electricity prices. The electricity bill has been reduced to a huge amount per annum. An order has also been placed to HimUrja for the installation of solar streetlights under a HIMCOSTE project.



6. Jointly Origin LIFE and Govt. PG College, Nahan will organise extension program to spread awareness among the community regarding health and hygiene.

3. To jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
4. To jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
5. To exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students for limited period of time for purpose of education and/or research.

**Himalayan Institute of Computer Science**, Kala Amb, Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh and Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar Government Post Graduate College, Nahan, Himachal Pradesh, further agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be separately determined and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial agreements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation, etc.

#### **B. Joint Sponsored Research, Development and consulting**

**Himalayan Institute of Computer Science**, Kala Amb, Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh and Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar Government Post Graduate College, Nahan Himachal Pradesh agree to help identify and invite faculty member from the other institutions to participate in research and development programmes. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement.

#### **C. Exchange of Faculty and Staff**

**Himalayan Institute of Computer Science**, Kala Amb, Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh and Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar Government Post Graduate College, Nahan Himachal Pradesh agree to encourage collaboration between faculty and staff from the two institutions. Specifically, institutions will encourage members of their faculties to undertake short visits to, or take up fixed-term visiting assignment at, each other's institutions. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment, including those concerning stipend, travel, name of the concerned faculty members will be worked out mutually by both the institutions.

Notwithstanding the above, both the institution will examine ways to identify financial resources to fund the activities for their faculty and staff.






#### **D. Student Exchange**

Himalayan Institute of Computer Science, Kala Amb, Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh and Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar Government Post Graduate College, Nahan Himachal Pradesh agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below. (A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student, and from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period of time to undertake a pre-determined programme of study or research.)

1. Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
2. An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution.
3. An exchange student will be considered full-time "exchange" student at the host institution.
4. His/her programme of study at host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor or mentor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.
5. The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.
6. If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out.
7. Both the institutions agree to provide suitable accommodation and living expenses for student exchange in accordance with the rules and regulation governing these institutions.
8. To avail travel expenses, the students can apply for existing funding programs at their respective home institutions.
9. The exchange students will pay tuition and other fees at their home institution.

#### **E. Exchange of Research and Educational Material**

Himalayan Institute of Computer Science, Kala Amb, Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh and Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar Government Post Graduate College, Nahan Himachal Pradesh will



exchange information on research and educational programmes and teaching/learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes. Further, both institutions agree to explore ways to share teaching/learning material, and other relevant literature, while respecting each other's intellectual property and other rights.

#### **F. Joint Seminars, Conferences, Workshops and short-Term Courses**

Himalayan Institute of Computer Science, Kala Amb, Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh and Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar Government Post Graduate College, Nahan Himachal Pradesh agree to help identify and invite faculty members from other institutions to participate in seminars, conferences, workshops, and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between both the institutions.

#### **G. Intellectual Property**

Himalayan Institute of Computer Science, Kala Amb, Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar Government Post Graduate College, Nahan Himachal Pradesh agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

#### **H. Coordination**

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programmes on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee, consisting of (a) Director, Himalayan Institute of Computer Science, Kala Amb, Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh or his nominee and (b) Principal, Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar Government Post Graduate College, Nahan Himachal Pradesh or his nominee, (c) Programme coordinator from the side of Himalayan Institute of Management, Kala Amb and (d) Programme coordinator from the side of Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar Government Post Graduate College, Nahan Himachal will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.






### **I. Tenure and Termination**
