

I. Academic Audit



Academic Audit Report 2024-25

OBSERVATION OF THE AUDIT COMMITTEE:

1. Induction programme for students of various streams are organized in the beginning of the session to familiarize students with the academic structure, program outcome, course outcome and evaluation pattern of the programme.
2. Curriculum feedback from all the stakeholders has been obtained, analysed and corrective actions were taken wherever needed.
3. Bridge courses and remedial classes are taken regularly.
4. Reservation roasters are applied for providing equal opportunity and fairness in admissions in various programmes.
5. Internal evaluation system/CCA is transparent. Assessment criteria, marking schemes and deadlines are clearly communicated to students in advance to ensure transparency and clarity.
6. All departments within the college conduct diverse activities designed to promote subject-specific enrichment, broaden knowledge horizons, and nurture the comprehensive growth of students.
7. Various departments organized educational tours and industrial visits which enhance the understanding of professional skills, promote experiential learning, and broaden the perspective of students on career opportunities.
8. The college campus has well-maintained green areas Yashwant Vatika and Botanical Garden which create a clean, serene, and eco-friendly learning environment. Various green initiatives such as regular plantation drives, waste management practices, and promotion of sustainable habits reflect the commitment of institution to environmental conservation.
9. Various student clubs and societies—including NCC, NSS, Rangers & Rovers, Road Safety Club, Eco-Club, Red Ribbon Club, Animal Club, Chemicos, Commerce Club and the Literary Society—are actively functional throughout the academic year.
10. The Mentor-Mentee system is fully operational, providing students with continuous emotional and psychological support. Regular interactions between teacher and student address academic concerns, personal challenges, and overall well-being of students thereby creating student-centered learning environment.
11. Teachers attended Orientation, Refresher, Short Term Course and Faculty Development Programmes during the year.

12. Students gain extensive exposure through diverse co-curricular, sports, and cultural activities organized throughout the year. Many students have proudly represented the college at District, State, Inter-University, and National level competitions.
13. The college conducts environment audit, academic audit and energy audit annually.
14. Career Counseling and Placement Cell organizes various seminars, lectures, career guidance sessions & placement drives in collaboration with various educational coaching institutes and employment generating agencies/firms.
15. The college proudly hosted the IIPU Inter College Kabaddi Championship (Women), reflecting its strong tradition of organizing major university events, highlighting its efficient management and vibrant campus culture.
16. The college has an efficient SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE that ensures smooth processing of various government scholarships schemes for eligible students. In addition to government schemes, S.C. Joshi Scholarship for academic excellence (one each for girls and boys) and a Sports Scholarship (one each for girls and boys) are ~~generously~~ awarded by two retired Principals of the college, encouraging merit and talent.
17. The vocational courses in Hospitality and Tourism and Retail Management are successfully running in ~~college~~ and ~~students enrolled in these courses~~ actively attended on job training programmes conducted in collaboration with industries and hotels.
18. A Girls' Hostel with a capacity of 120 students is currently under construction in the college under the PM USTHA scheme. This initiative aims to enhance residential facilities for female students.
19. The college has a fully Wi-Fi enabled campus, ensuring seamless connectivity for students and faculty. Classrooms are equipped with interactive panels, promoting an engaging and technology-driven learning environment.
20. The college extended academic support to neighboring institutions by providing online lectures to help them manage staff shortages. By sharing its resources and expertise, the college contributed to strengthening the overall educational ecosystem of the region.

21. The construction of water harvesting system, Basket ball court and levelling of college ground and levelling of ground at Girls' Hostel Nalini is under PWD department for construction. The New BCA Block is also under construction.
22. The college library is registered with the National Digital Library of India (NDLI) and subscribes to the OJODA (One JODA One Subscription) Initiative through Inflibnet, providing access to a vast collection of digital resources.
23. The college has signed Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with industries and educational institutions, aiming to sensitize students to entrepreneurship skills and inculcating academic excellence through collaborative initiatives.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE AUDIT COMMITTEE.

1. Faculty members should strive for recognition of awards, fellowships at state, national and international level from government recognized bodies.
2. Collaborative activities for research, faculty exchange, student exchange be enhanced.
3. Faculty be encouraged to design e-content like SWAYAM and other MOOC's platform or any other government initiative. Faculty Development Programs, seminars and conferences should be organized in the college.
4. Incubation centre be created and start-ups be incubated on campus.
5. Efforts can be made by the faculty members to enroll the students on e-PATHSHALA, SWAYAM and MOOC's and designing content for the same.
6. Inter-collegic co-curricular activities can be promoted.
7. More green & clean campus initiatives may be taken through clubs and societies to promote environmental awareness among students.
8. Internal Grievance Redressal Cell should be formulated for resolving the issues of the students.
9. Provision of recreation room and crèche may be made.
10. The involvement of students in community-oriented initiatives, cultural activities and sports events is appreciable. In this direction, however, extension activities as well as society linked programs between college and society can be enhanced.
11. More field projects/ internship may be encouraged to undertake.
12. There is a need to enhance the use of ICT in teaching and learning process.

13. More collaboration may be encouraged and more MoUs can be signed.
14. The college should strive to achieve permanent affiliation for all its courses from the affiliating university, ensuring academic stability and recognition.
15. New courses under self-financing scheme may be started.
16. Career Counseling and Placement Cell may be strengthened with future perspectives of students.
17. There is a need of Auditorium and separate PG Block in the campus.
18. Indoor and outdoor sports areas should be established.
19. The vacant faculty posts in various departments should be filled.
20. Teacher-Taught ratio should be proportionate.
21. There should be separate computer lab for the students of computer applications.


Career Counseling and Placement Cell
