(Min. 5000 or equivalent value)**

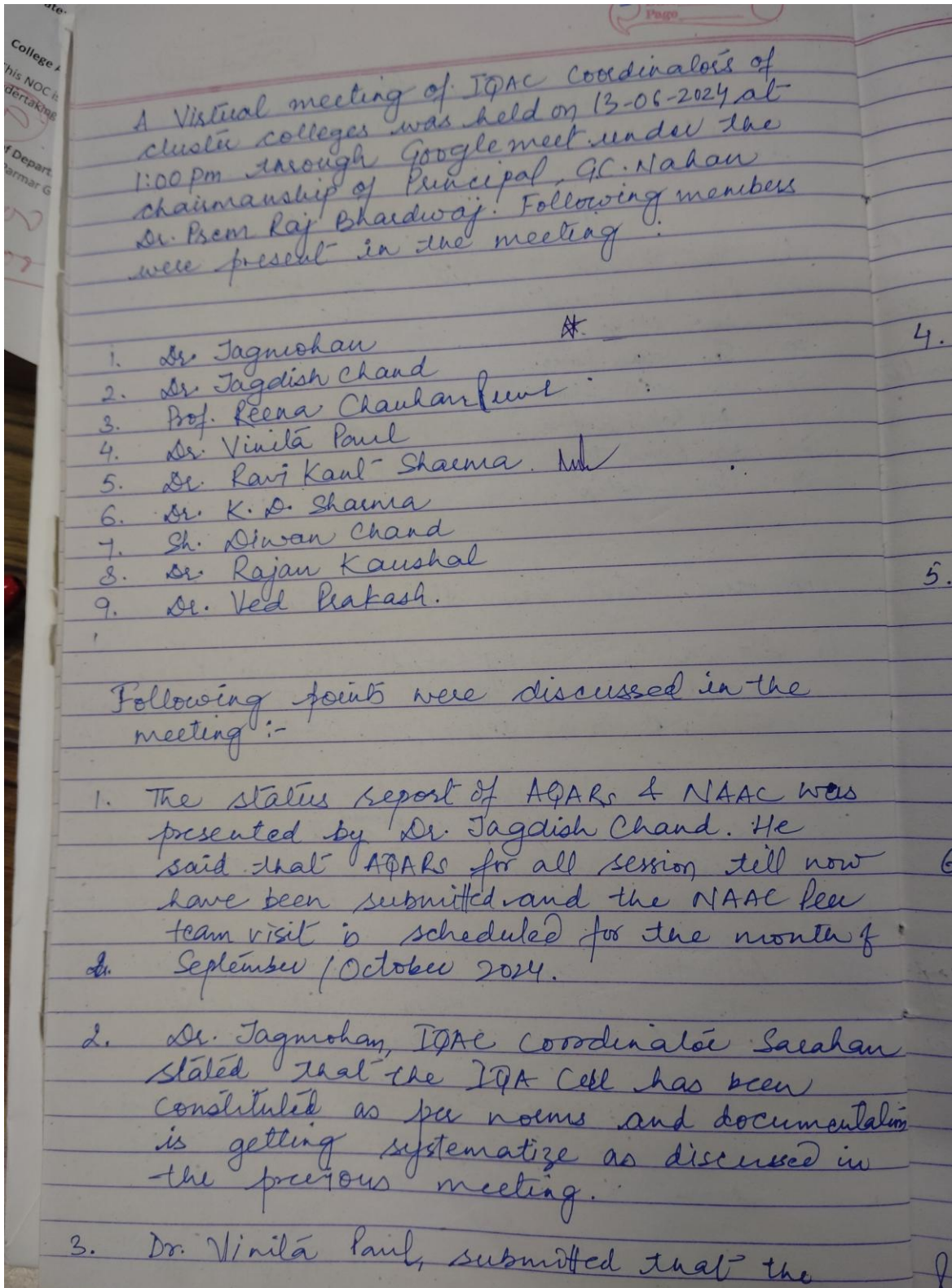
The institution, as a lead college under the cluster system believes in material and infrastructural support to partner colleges to strengthen academic collaboration and resource equity. During 2025-26, the college undertook the initiative of repairing computers for use by cluster colleges, thereby ensuring their functional readiness and usability. Additionally, the institution is in the process of donating these refurbished computers to GC Sarahan to enhance ICT-enabled teaching-learning facilities. The total value of the assistance exceeds ₹5000.

This effort has significantly contributed to strengthening inter-institutional collaboration, promoting digital learning infrastructure, and ensuring optimal utilization of available resources within the cluster framework.

i. VIRTUAL CONFERENCE WITH IQAC COORDINATORS

To address this, the college has submitted an application to UGC for the re-issuance of the documents.

ii. Resource Persons for service training of vocational trainers under NSQF Project during 2023 and 2025.




