

5.3. Social Impact of Extension Activities:

I. Issues related to sanitation and water was resolved by the involvement of NSS volunteers.

The NSS units of the college go on a yearly basis to their adopted Gram panchayat Sain ki Sair which comprises of various villages like Chabbah, Thalinga Lahan etc. NSS volunteers conducted the yearly based survey to find out the changes experienced by the people compared to last year in terms of the challenges related to access to basic amenities. This year, the Up – Pradhan of the panchayat Mr. Satendra Thakur told the volunteers that due to their advocacy last year on the two major issues in these villages related to sanitation and availability of water was done by the NSS volunteers, by taking these issues to the media and government authorities, this year various new development projects had been initiated in the panchayat. The panchayat is now Nirmal panchayat as toilets have been constructed for all the houses and secondly, Har Ghar Jal scheme under Jal Jeevan Mission has also been successfully implemented. Secondly, this year volunteers also focused on meeting with the local leaders who play a key role in strengthening the administration of the area. Smt. Rekha Devi, Pradhan of the panchayat met with the volunteers, discussing local issues concerning the area and gave a lecture advocating female participation in administration as well as the important role of the youth in development matters.



Introduction:

The socio-economic survey of Sain Ki Sher village, Himachal Pradesh, was part of the ongoing efforts under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. It involved the participation of NSS volunteers who worked closely with local families to understand their living conditions, economic activities, social structure, and educational status. **This was a follow-up survey to one conducted in February 2023, which had provided valuable insights into the village's infrastructural and social issues.** A socio-economic and educational survey was conducted in the village of Sain Ki Sher, Himachal Pradesh. The survey aimed to gather detailed information about the population, economic activities, animal husbandry, and social structure of the households. The following report highlights key findings from the survey, which can help in understanding the village's demographic and economic characteristics.

Key Findings from the 2023 Survey:

एवएसएस के कार्यक्रम जाधकारी प्रोपंतरर पंकल वाइक ने बताया कि इस दौरान गांव के उपप्रधान सर्वेद सिंह व कोमदन धी मीजुद रहे। उन्होंने बताया कि सरकार को योजनाओं का धरानाल पर किस तरह से उतर रही है का सर्वे रक्षयंसेवकों द्वारा किया गया, क्रिसमें निमांल सोपित राम पंचायत सैन की सेर में पाया गया है कि अभी भी जार से पांच परिवार के पास निवा हरीखालय नहां है। वहां यह परिवार सालंबनिक शॉवालयों का प्रयोग कर रहे हैं। वहां जुक्के पंतापत निर्मल पोषित हो चुको हैं तो यहां शीवालय निर्माप इत्यादि के लिए भी सरकारी फेड नहाँ मिल सकता है।

वहीं यह भी सर्वे के दीरान पाया गया है कि पंचायत के लीग पेपजल को लभी भी खड़ु से आपुति कर रहे हैं। वहीं सरकार की ओर से पेप्रवल घोनना का लाभ लोगों को यहां नहीं मिल पा रहा है। एनएसएस कार्वक्रम जेथिकारी प्रोफेसर पंजल्ज चोहक ने बताया कि एनएसएस के सात दिवसीय आवासीय हिलिर में महाविद्यालय के 80 छात्र- हावाएं बिरोध से जा अभियान में हिस्सा ले रहे हैं।

जिसके तहत नाहम क्षेत्र के आठ किलोमीटर के दायर के पांच गोर्वों की एडाप्ट कर यहां पर सेवा अभियान की च्लाया यया है। वादी सापंकालीन यातिविधियों में सांस्कृतिक कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया जा रहा है। In the February 2023 survey, Sain Ki Sher was documented as an Open Defecation Free (ODF) Panchayat. However, the survey revealed a significant gap—5 households were found to lack toilet facilities. This issue came to light due to the separation of joint families, which had not been reflected in official records. When these findings were conveyed to the Gram Panchayat and district authorities through media channels, the matter was investigated, and the affected households were subsequently provided with toilet facilities.

2024 Survey Overview:

In February 2024, another detailed survey was carried out with the help of NSS volunteers. The focus of this survey was to reassess the improvements made since the last year, particularly regarding sanitation facilities, and to gather updated socio-economic data.

A. Population Structure:


The village consists of multiple families, with an average family size of 4 to 5 members. Both men and women are equally represented in the population, indicating balanced gender distribution. The number of children per household varies between 1 to 3.

B. Livestock Ownership:

Animal husbandry is a vital part of the village economy. Most households own cows, while a smaller percentage of households also keep bulls and goats. Ownership of other animals was reported in a few cases. This suggests that dairy farming plays a significant role in the village's livelihood.

C. Economic Activities:

The survey indicates diverse sources of income among the families. Occupations range from farming to employment in local construction departments. Annual income levels vary significantly, with some households earning as much as ₹13,00,000, while others have an annual income as low as ₹50,000. The disparity in income highlights varying economic conditions among families.




D. Social and Religious Composition:

The majority of the population follows the Hindu religion. Caste composition includes a mix of general and scheduled caste (SC) families. This diversity in social structure is typical of rural villages in Himachal Pradesh, where traditional occupations and social divisions continue to influence community life.

Conclusion:

The village of Sain Ki Sher reflects a traditional Himachali rural structure, where agriculture, livestock rearing, and government employment contribute to the economy. The religious and social composition of the village showcases a predominantly Hindu community with a mix of castes. The survey data provides valuable insights that can guide development initiatives focused on improving economic opportunities and promoting educational growth in the village.

The socio-economic survey of Sain Ki Sher has highlighted the village's progress in sanitation, economic activities, and education. The efforts of NSS volunteers, along with the guidance of Dr. Pankaj Chandak, Prof. Lakshita, and Prof. Devendra, have helped bring attention to critical issues, such as sanitation gaps. The successful provision of toilet facilities to households identified in the previous survey exemplifies the impact that such initiatives can have on rural development.
