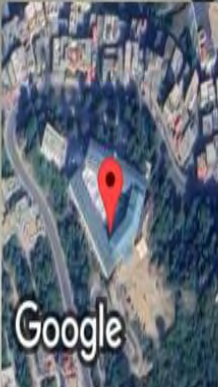
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9. Senior Journalist Sailesh delivered a lecture on The Role of Journalism in Cultural Preservation: Insights and Techniques

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

11. Dr. Pradeep Sharma, DFO delivered a lecture on Living a Meaningful Life: Perspectives on Responsibility and Freedom



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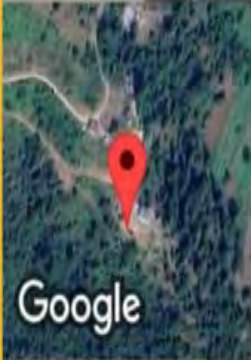
